## Evening meals

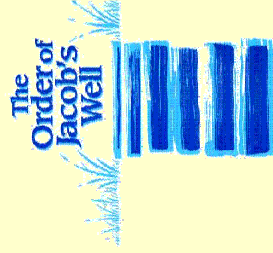

Mike Endicott writes of this year’s main conference speaker “My old friend Roy has a vision to see Houses of Prayer established throughout Britain and Europe. This has grown out of the reality of what has happened at Ffald-y-Brenin in southwest Wales as the community there committed themselves to a rhythm of prayer, thankfulness and blessing.

He is, so they tell me, a short, bearded man. He’s hospitable and patient with people but has an evangelist’s hunger to see lives transformed by the life and message of Jesus.

He’s certainly gentle but there’s also a certain steeliness, a tough minded realism that holds people accountable and doesn’t flinch from the helpful but often difficult question. There is a persistent humility about him too, demonstrated as he leaves people to hear from God after praying for them. Their subsequent encounters with the Holy Spirit are clearly God’s work as Roy has usually quietly excused himself from the scene.

I have spent a good few hours (not enough yet!) sitting at his feet and learning from him. His Conference bible studies 2009 are going to be rich, exciting and relationship building with the living god!”

## WORSHIP LEADER : Guy Ben Murphrey



Guy Ben Murphrey has been a worship leader since the Lord Jesus changed his life in 1972. He presently serves the Lord in Houston, Texas as the contemporary worship leader at Garden Oaks Baptist Church. In addition, he leads worship at events in the area such as Healing Missions at St. John the Divine Episcopal, Kingdom Advancers International, and in conjunction with other ministries. He is the president of Kena Naya Ministries, a worship-based organization whose mission is to “establish and strengthen worship to the Living God until His glory covers the earth”. He believes that an atmosphere of praise and worship is not only one in which we should live daily, but an especially effective way to receive the blessings of God’s presence, including anointing and healing. He also works with churches and ministries for the purpose of raising up and making worship teams more effective. He is a recording engineer and producer, and plays the piano, trumpet, guitar, and pennywhistle.
